Project Sunset continues to move forward. Had a meeting with restaurant people looking at a location, finding a new location for Golden Years. Working on 400 acre project just outside of the city.

In Madera County, had a meeting for a sports training facility project, ecommerce facility and a tentative new project. Met with Richard Spencer and attended a SIOR virtual event and will attend a live Nor Cal SIOR live event next week. Facilitated a stakeholders meeting for a truck driving school, a huge need with the average age for a driver being 61 years old. Met with Colliers on a large distribution/ecommerce project. Attended the Mountain Communities Chamber Alliance, we will continue to be their administrative arm as they terminated themselves as a committee of MCEDC. Met with three companies on the virtual marketing mission.
